## Federal Tax Election Update in Workday

Employee instructions to Enter or Update a Federal Withholding Election in Workday.

Effective January 1, 2020 the new IRS Form W-4 (2020), must be used. <u>You no longer have the option</u> to enter allowances. You now have the options to claim dependents, enter other income and/or enter deductions you will be able to claim at year-end.

- 2. Click the Pay Worklet
